

Golfers have volcano to climb

US-BASED Kiawah Development Partners has started work on an 18-hole championship golf course on the island of St Kitts (pictured) in the Caribbean.

It will form part of a new 2,500-acre resort called Christophe Harbour which

will also include a yacht marina as well as restaurants, shops, hotels, oceanfront and hillside properties and residential villas.

The course, created by Tom Fazio, is scheduled to be open for play in 2011. It will be built on top of a volcanic

ridge and along an inland cove. The winds will influence shot selection in some holes.

Planned over 250 acres, the par 72 course will be 7,250 yards from the back tees.
